THE COMPANIES (LIMITED LIABILITY) LAWS, 1922 TO 1944.

#### LICENCE UNDER SECTION 20.

Whereas it has been proved to the satisfaction of His Excellency the Acting Governor that the Association of the Junior School which is about to be formed as a limited company under the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1944, is to be formed for the purpose of promoting objects of the nature contemplated by section 20 of the said Laws, and that it is the intention of the said Association that the profits, if any, or the income or property of the Association, whencesoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association, as set forth in the Memorandum of Association of the said Association and that no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend or bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to its members or to any of them or to any person claiming through any of them :

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by section 20 of the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1944, and in consideration of the provisions and subject to the conditions contained in the Memorandum of Association of the said Association, as subscribed by seven members thereof and approved by the Court, His Excellency the Acting Governor does by this licence direct the Association of the Junior School to be registered with limited liability, without the addition of the word "Limited" to its name.
