In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 (2) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1947, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby order as follows:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) Amendment Order, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Suppl. No.3: Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) Order, 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) Orders, 1947 and 1948.
 - 2. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) by the insertion therein in the proper alphabetical order of the words "Perakhorio-Nisou" and "Potamia-Ayios Sozomenos" in column 2 under the heading "Nicosia District" in respect of the Greek-Orthodox religious community;

(b) by the deletion therefrom of the words "Dhromolaxia-Meneou" in column 2 under the heading "Larnaca District" in respect of

the Greek-Orthodox religious community;

(c) by the insertion therein in the proper alphabetical order of the words "Argaki-Morphou" in column 2 under the heading "Nicosia District" in respect of the Moslem religious

community:

(d) by the deletion therefrom of the words "Skylloura-Ayios Vasilios" in column 2 under the heading "Nicosia District" and "Lemba-Kissonerga" in column 2 under the heading "Paphos District" in respect of the Moslem religious community, and the substitution therefor of the words "Skylloura-Avios Vasilios-Ayia Marina Skyllouras" and "Lemba-Kissonerga-Emba ", respectively.
