## THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 3) 1948.

Order under Section 35 (2).

WINSTER,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 35 (2) of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 3) 1948, I, the Governor, do hereby order and declare that aircraft belonging to any air transport company of any state which is a contracting party to the Convention of International Civil Aviation done at Chicago the 7th day of December, 1944, engaged in international air navigation to, from or through the Colony and any engines, spare parts and equipment carried and exclusively used on such aircraft, and any fuel and oil so carried and used, and any fuel and oil taken on board such aircraft for the purpose of flying to parts beyond the seas shall be exempt from the payment of import duties and other duties or dues.

THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW, 1946.
