## SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTIONS 3 (2) AND 12B.

WINSTER,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 3 (2) and 12s of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Enemy Territory Cessation) (Albania) Order, 1948.
- 2. Albania shall for the purposes of sections 5A, 6, 7 and 9 of the Law and for the purposes of any Order made under section 9 cease to be treated as if it were enemy territory.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 3 of the Law, any person, unless I otherwise direct, may trade within Albania with any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) resident or carrying on business therein.
- 4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 31st May, 1948.
