Order under Section 1.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 1 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, and delegated to me by Notification No. 172 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th June, 1947, I, Arthur William Green, Commissioner of the District of Paphos, do hereby order that a new burial ground shall be provided, under the provisions of the said Laws, for use by the Orthodox-Christian community of the village of Kili in Paphos District, in lieu of the burial ground now in use by the said community.

Rules.

These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of "Merika Water" Akaki (Amendment) Rules, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of "Merika Water" Akaki, Rules, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of "Merika Water" Akaki Rules, 1942 and 1948.

2. Rule 5 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion thereform of the word "six" and the substitution thereform of the word "twenty". (M.P. 592/42.)
