- (c) that the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Municipal Corporation for the erection of a slaughter-house and the construction of a road leading to the slaughter-house.
- 2. That, for the purpose of securing the repayment of the sum under the loan, the Municipal Corporation is hereby authorized, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, to mortgage to the Lender all the rates, fees and duties now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Municipal Corporation.
