**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
ACT, 1945.**

ORDER MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, as extended to the Colony by the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Colonies, etc.) Order in Council, 1946, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence (Exportation of Goods) (Amendment) Regulations, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Exportation of Goods) Regulations, 1943, mentioned in item 6 of the Second Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which have effect by virtue of the Act aforementioned (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Defence (Exportation of Goods) Regulations, 1943 and 1948.

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2. Sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) of regulation 4 of the principal Regulations shall be varied to read and to have effect as follows:—

"(a) all goods enumerated in the Schedule hereto may be exported without a licence to destinations within the British Empire (with the exception of Hong-Kong, Sarawak and the British Pacific Islands);"
