THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAKISTRA UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Chakistra hereby make the following rules:—
