In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:

This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Gazettes: Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1946 to 1947, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal 27.12.1946 Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail 17. 4.1947 Rate of Postage) Orders, 1946 to 1948.
