No. 66. THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 61.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Agricultural Produce Control) (Amendment) Order, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Agricultural Produce Control) Order, 1946, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Agricultural Produce Control) Orders, 1946 and 1948.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the definition "Agricultural Produce" and the substitution therefor of the following definition:—

"Agricultural Produce" means barley and wheat.
