**THE AIR NAVIGATION (LICENSING OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT)

No. 9. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, and with reference to the Notification dated the 7th day of November, 1947, and published under No. 344 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th November, 1947, relating to the establishment of a permanent Battalion Camp at Dhekelia, in the District of Larnaca, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to sanction and hereby sanctions the acquisition, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws, of the immovable properties situated within the limits of the village of Pyla, particulars whereof are specifically set out in the notice of the Commissioner, Larnaca, published under Notification No. 358 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 20th November, 1947, to vest and be registered in the name of His Majesty's Military Authorities.
