

No. 99. THE DANGEROUS DRUGS LAWS, 1925 TO 1932.**ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2281**

MADE UNDER SECTION 11 (2).

Whereas it appears to the Governor that the drugs set out in the Schedule hereto are productive, if improperly used, or are capable of being converted into a substance which is, or is likely to be, productive, if improperly used, of ill effects substantially of the same character or nature as or analogous to those produced by Indian hemp, morphine or cocaine :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 11 (2) of the Dangerous Drugs Laws, 1925 to 1932, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order and declare that Part III of the Dangerous Drugs Laws, 1925 to 1932, shall apply to the drugs set out in the Schedule hereto in the same manner as the said Part III applies to the drugs mentioned in section 11 (1) of the Dangerous Drugs Laws, 1925 to 1932.

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1948.

SCHEDULE.

1. Amidone (dl-2-dimethylamino-4 : 4-diphenylheptane-5-one) its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of amidone ;
2. Methyl dihydromorphinone (commonly known as Metopon), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of methyl dihydromorphinone.

No. 100. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1948.**ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2282**

MADE UNDER SECTION 65 (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 65 (b) of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Wharfage Dues (Foreign Broadcast Information Service) Exemption Order, 1948.

2. All materials and equipment imported for the construction and operation of the Monitoring Station run by the above-mentioned organization shall be exempt from the payment of any wharfage dues for import.

3. This Order shall be deemed to have been made on the 21st day of November, 1947.
