THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2345

MADE UNDER SECTION 206.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 206 of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Municipal Corporations Laws (Amendment of the First Schedule) Regulations, 1949.

2. The Regulations contained in the First Schedule to the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948 (as set out in section 16 of Law 34 of 1948) are hereby amended by the insertion at the end of regulation 4 thereof of the following paragraph:—

“(3) Any person who claims that any of the particulars in the lists respecting himself is incorrect may, not later than the 18th day of March (inclusive), after the posting of the lists as hereinbefore provided, by letter handed to the Commissioner, request him to have such particulars corrected and, thereupon, the Commissioner, if satisfied that, though there is no doubt as to the identity of the applicant any of the particulars respecting him is in fact incorrect, may forthwith correct the lists accordingly by initialling the corrections.”
