**No. 150. THE RURAL CONSTABLES LAWS, 1932 TO 1949.**

**GROUPING OF VILLAGES.**

By virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 3 of the Rural Constables Laws, 1932 to 1949, and duly delegated to me under Notification No. 172, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th June, 1947, I, on the recommendation of the Commissioner of Nicosia, hereby direct that the villages of Petra tou Dhiyeni and Kourou Monastir in the District of Nicosia shall, with effect from the 1st May, 1949, be united into a group for the purposes of the said Laws.

And I also direct that the Mukhtar of the Village Commission of Petra tou Dhiyeni shall be the Mukhtar of the Group Commission for all the purposes of the said Laws.

**No. 151. THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) LAW, 1880.**

**ORDER UNDER SECTION 2 (1) (l).**

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 (1) (l) of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Law, 1880, duly deputed to me under section 4 of the said Law by paragraph 3 of the Notification No. 527 published in the *Gazette* of the 3rd July, 1931, I, Robert Justin Roe, Chief Veterinary Officer, hereby order as follows:—

1. All sheep and goats in the Colony, with the exception of sheep and goats within the village areas of the villages set out in the Schedule hereto, shall be inoculated with anthrax vaccine.

2. The inoculations shall be carried out by Veterinary Officers or by such Vaccinators as may be appointed by me in writing in that behalf.
