Whereas His Excellency the Acting Governor is satisfied that in order to preserve the amenities of the ancient monument set out as item 11 in the Nicosia District, in the Second Schedule of the Antiquities Laws, 1935 and 1945, it is desirable that no building should be erected in the proximity of such ancient monument upon the plots of land described in the Schedule hereto and that any buildings thereon should be demolished:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 12 of the Antiquities Laws, 1935 and 1945, His Excellency the Acting Governor is pleased to direct and hereby directs that the plots of land and the buildings described in the Schedule hereto be acquired on payment of such amount by way of compensation as may be agreed upon between the Commissioner of Nicosia and the proprietors of the said plots of land and the buildings and that in default of agreement within one month from the date hereof the amount of compensation be determined in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947.
