# NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66.

It is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 66 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 3) 1948, and duly deputed to me, I hereby approve the premises described in the third column of the Schedule hereto, belonging to the person whose name is set out in the first column of that Schedule and occupied by the persons whose names are set out in the second column of that Schedule, to be a private warehouse for the warehousing of the goods specified in the fourth column of the said Schedule without payment of import duties upon the first entry of such goods therein.

THE TREE PLANTING (VILLAGE AREAS) LAW, 1948.

### ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 12.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Tembria in the District of Nicosia on the 19th day of September, 1948, under the provisions of the Tree Planting (Village Areas) Law, 1948, it was determined by the requisite majority of the owners present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the said village of Tembria;

And whereas the Mukhtar of the said village of Tembria has forwarded to me a report signed and sealed by him containing a description of the area in question with boundaries and particulars and stating that such area fulfils the conditions prescribed in section 10 (4) of the said Law:

Now, therefore, I, the Commissioner of the District of Nicosia, having approved of the said report, do by this order declare that the area described in the Schedule hereto shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the said village of Tembria.
