

along a footpath to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 546 of the said plan; thence southwards and eastwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 547, 553, 554, 542, 511, 512, 533 and 514 of the said plan, to the north-eastern corner of the last mentioned plot, locality "Nannatidhes", which corner is at the junction of footpaths; thence southwards along a footpath to the road leading from the village of Nikos to the village of Tembria; thence southwards along the said road to its junction with a footpath, which junction is at the north-western corner of plot No. 688 of the said plan; thence along the said footpath to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 709 of the said plan, locality "Sklinikia"; thence south-eastwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 710, 736, 742, 741 and 740 of the said plan, locality "Matsouka", plots Nos. 108, 114, 104, 121, 118, 135, 144, 143, 152 and 151 of Government Survey Plan No. XXXVII.4, to the boundary between the villages of Tembria and Kaliana; thence southwards and westwards along the said village boundary to the south-western corner of plot No. 74 of the said plan, locality "Skhismolaona", which corner is on a road; thence northwards along the said road to its junction with a footpath at the most northern point of plot No. 66 of the said plan; thence westwards along the said footpath to the stream at the most southern point of plot No. 64 of the said plan; thence northwards along the said stream to the point of commencement, all which said area comprises 965 donums or thereabouts and is shown edged in red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1435.

**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

**ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 61:**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Wheat Control) Order, 1949.

2. In this Order—

“authorized purchaser” means a person or body of persons duly authorized by the Wheat Controller to purchase wheat;

“producer” means any person who since the 1st day of September, 1948, has cultivated and produced any wheat either by his own labour or through his agents or servants;

“Wheat Controller” means an officer appointed by the Governor as Wheat Controller.

3. From and after the 9th day of May, 1949, no person, other than an authorized purchaser, shall purchase any wheat save under a written permit issued by the Wheat Controller or any person authorized by him on that behalf.

4. Save under a written permit issued by the Wheat Controller or any person authorized by him on that behalf, from and after the 9th May, 1949, no producer shall sell any wheat save to an authorized purchaser.

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5. No person who is not a producer or authorized purchaser or the holder of a permit issued under clause 3 and 4 of this Order, shall have in his possession or under his control any wheat in excess of the normal requirements for his household for one month.

6. Every person shall permit such person as the Wheat Controller or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.

7. Any person who acts in contravention of or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order is liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946.

8. The Defence (Agricultural Produce Control) Orders, 1946 to (No. 2) 1948 are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

No. 180. THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1938 TO 1949.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 to 1949, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of "Demma" Ayia Anna, in the District of Larnaca, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF "DEMMA" AYIA ANNA.

Rules.

1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of "Demma" Ayia Anna Rules, 1949.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the District of Larnaca;

"Committee" means the Committee of the Irrigation Division;

"Irrigation Division" means the Irrigation Division of

"Demma" Ayia Anna;

"Law" means the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 to 1949;

"list" means the list of the names and residence of the proprietors and of the lands and extent thereof which are to be benefited or are capable of being benefited by the works prepared under the provisions of section 15 of the Law as finally settled under the provisions of section 16 of the Law;

"works" means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Division.

3. The Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 9th January, 1949. Thereafter the election of the Committee shall take place every third year in the first week of the month of January, and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the day next following its election.

4.—(1) The Committee shall appoint a treasurer who shall collect the rates and charges assessed upon the proprietors mentioned in the list.

(2) The treasurer shall, on the 30th September in every year, prepare a statement of all rates or charges still due and unpaid on that date and shall forward such statement to the Commissioner.

(3) The treasurer shall be unpaid: Provided that he shall be paid such of his out of pocket expenses as may be sanctioned by the Committee.
