THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

ORDER MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 207 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 207 (1) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Municipal Elections (Closing of Licensed Premises) (Rural Municipalities) Order, 1949.

2. In this Order—

“licensed premises” means any premises licensed for the sale of intoxicating liquors by retail under the provisions of the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors Law, 1943.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors (Retailers Closing Hours) Orders, 1945 and 1949, all licensed premises situated within the municipal limits of the rural municipalities specified in the first column to the Schedule hereto shall, during the dates and hours specified in the second column of the said Schedule, be closed and remain closed.

THE TREE PLANTING (VILLAGE AREAS) LAW, 1948.
