

<u>Officer</u>	<u>Charges</u>
3. Temporary Health Inspector :	(a) For work at any time on any day other than a Sunday or public holiday before or after the hours of business, 1s. per hour. (b) For work on any Sunday or public holiday, 5s. per day : Provided that if the officer works for less than four hours on any such day the charge shall be 3s.
4. Quarantine Temporary Guard :	(a) For work at any time on any day other than a Sunday or public holiday before or after the hours of business, 7½p. per hour. (b) For work on any Sunday or public holiday, 4s. per day : Provided that if the officer works for less than four hours on any such day the charge shall be 2s.

Note.—For the purposes of this Schedule the hours of business shall be as follows :—

- (a) From the 1st June to the 31st October in every year—
 (i) on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, from 8 a.m. to noon and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. ;
 (ii) on Wednesdays, from 8 a.m. to noon and from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. ;
 (iii) on Saturdays, from 8 a.m. to noon.
 (b) From the 1st November in every year to the 31st May of the following year—
 (i) on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, from 8 a.m. to noon and from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. ;
 (ii) on Saturdays, from 8 a.m. to noon.”

(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

APPOINTMENT OF COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Defence Regulation 3 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby appoint the Controller of Supplies to be a Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulations 61, 61A, 63 and 83 as set out in the aforesaid Schedule.

2. This appointment is in addition to and not in derogation of any other appointment made for the purposes of the said Defence Regulations or any of them in respect of any officer or person other than the Controller of Supplies, Transport and Marketing, but without prejudice to anything done by any such officer or person.
