No. 200. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, and with reference to the Notification dated the 31st day of May, 1948, and published under No. 212 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 11th June, 1948, relating to certain lands on which the Military Authorities constructed a road, known as the "Limassol Bye-pass", situated within the municipal limits of Limassol town, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws, of the immovable properties situated in the aforesaid town, particulars whereof are specifically set out in the notice of the Commissioner, Limassol, published under Notification No. 422 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 25th November, 1948, to vest and be registered in the name of the Government.

No. 201. THE FOREST REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 6.

It is hereby notified for general information that in virtue of the authority vested in him by regulation 6 of the Forest Regulations, 1940 to 1944, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to declare that the Minor State Forests, the areas of which are set out in the Schedule to the Minor State Forests (Nicosia, Kyrenia and Paphos) Orders, 1942 to 1949, as may be amended at any time, shall be reserved as Village Fuel Areas, with the exception of any such areas which are situated within the lands of villages being a municipal corporation which shall be reserved as Municipal Fuel Areas.

2. The Notice published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 23rd October, 1947, under Notification No. 320 is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done thereunder.
