NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Acting Governor is pleased to declare and hereby declares that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to (No. 2) 1948, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

the 24th March, 1949, is hereby cancelled.
