## THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2358

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

*Authority to the Village Health Commission of Pano Panayia (Paphos District) to contract a loan.*R. E. TURNBULL,  
*Acting Governor.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. That the Village Health Commission of Pano Panayia (Paphos District) (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") is hereby authorized to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of one hundred pounds (£100) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

- (a) That the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Commission to the Lender in six equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest).
- (b) That the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Commission for the purpose of completing the village market.

2. That for the purposes of securing the repayment of the sums due under the loan the Commission is hereby authorized, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, to mortgage to the Lender all charges and rates now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Commission under the provisions of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948.

THE BRITISH NATIONALITY (OFFENCES AND FEES)  
LAW, 1949.

## REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 4.

R. E. TURNBULL,  
*Acting Governor.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the British Nationality (Offences and Fees) Law, 1949, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the British Nationality (Fees) Regulations, 1949, and shall be read in conjunction with the British Nationality Regulations, 1948.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of this regulation, the fees specified in the Schedule hereto may be taken and shall be applied in the manner set out in the said Schedule.

(2) Of the fee payable in respect of the grant of a certificate of naturalization, one pound shall be payable on the submission of the application for a certificate and shall in no circumstances be returned, and the balance shall be payable on the receipt of the decision to grant a certificate:

Provided that where a husband and wife apply at the same time for certificates and are residing together at the time of the applications and the balance is paid in respect of the grant of a certificate to one of them, no balance shall be payable in respect of the grant of a certificate to the other.

(3) All fees shall be payable to the District Treasury of the District in which the applicant resides.

3. The Naturalization Regulations, 1925 and 1934 are hereby repealed.
