**THE FOREST (PROTECTION AGAINST INCENDIARISM)
LAW, 1946.**

THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW, 1933.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, 1933, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Potato) Export (Amendment) Regulations, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Produce (Potato) Export Regulations, 1935 to 1937 (hereinafter called "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Potato) Export Regulations, 1935 to 1949.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein, at the beginning thereof, of the following definition:—

“‘Certified Seed Potatoes’ means potatoes the produce of a crop which was inspected whilst growing in the field by a member of the Department of Agriculture, and in respect of which labels in the form shown in the First Schedule hereto have been issued.”

3. Regulation 6 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein, at the end thereof, of the following item:—

“Certified Seed Potatoes C.S.”.

4. Regulation 10 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the insertion in the first line of paragraph 1 thereof of the words “and Certified Seed Potatoes” immediately after the words “potatoes for seed purposes”;
- (b) by the substitution in the first line of paragraph (2) thereof for the word “box” of the word “package”;
- (c) by the deletion of paragraph 2 (b) thereof and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph:—
“Either the words ‘For Seed Purposes’ or the words ‘Certified Seed Potatoes’”;
- (d) by the insertion therein, immediately after paragraph (2) thereof, of the following paragraph:—
“(3) Certified Seed Potatoes shall in addition comply with the following description:—
(i) there shall be affixed by the grower on each bag a label, in the form in the First Schedule hereto, issued by the Director of Agriculture, showing the name of the variety of the seed potatoes and the number allotted to the grower;
(ii) there shall be marked on each bag containing Certified Seed Potatoes the words ‘Certified Seed Potatoes’”.

5. Regulation 14 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein, at the end thereof, of the following paragraph:—

“(3) Immediately after the inspection the Produce Inspector shall cause each bag passed as Certified Seed Potatoes to be sealed with a lead seal, and shall further cause to be affixed thereon a label bearing the words ‘Department of Agriculture, Cyprus: Certified Seed Potatoes’ and the name of the variety.”

6. Regulation 15 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein (line 9) immediately before the word “Schedule” of the word “Second”.

7. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately before the Schedule thereto, of the following First Schedule the existing Schedule being renamed as Second Schedule:—

“FIRST SCHEDULE.

(Regulation 10.)

Government of Cyprus.
Department of Agriculture.
Certified Seed Label.
Department of Agriculture, Cyprus.
Certified Seed Potatoes.
‘(Name of variety)’ (40 okes).
Grower’s No. 19. . . .”
