## NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me, as appropriate authority, by section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, 1946, I, the Commissioner of Limassol, with the approval of the Governor, do hereby define the area described in the Schedule hereto as a zone reserved exclusively for residential purposes, excluding, however, hotels, boarding houses, lodging houses and khans.

#### SCHEDULE.

All that zone of land situated within 500 yards of each side of the Nicosia-Palekhori-Troodos main road between mileposts 44 and 45.

# THE TREE PLANTING (VILLAGE AREAS) LAW, 1948.

#### RIZOKARPASO (FAMAGUSTA) FUND.
