THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as a Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Medical Supplies) (Revocation) Order, 1949.

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION
OF ATHIENOU.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Athienou hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Athienou Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Athienou Municipal Corporation Bye-laws, 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Athienou Municipal Corporation Bye-laws, 1948 and 1949.

2. Paragraph (1) of bye-law 84 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—

"(1) Whenever all the domestic needs of all persons entitled to a supply of drinking water have been satisfied and there is a surplus quantity of drinking water available for irrigation purposes such surplus quantity may be disposed of by the Municipal Corporation to persons residing within the municipal limits on payment of such fees as may be determined from time to time by the Council, but not exceeding 45 piastres for every hour of supply of such water or in proportion for a lesser period".

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Acting Governor.
