THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1949.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 74 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 74 (1) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1949, His Excellency the Acting Governor hereby directs that the additional tax mentioned in section 65 of the said Laws payable by the Maronite tax-payers of the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall, in respect of the year 1950, be increased by the rate per thousand mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule, to provide the amount required for the payment of loans or annual maintenance of the Maronite Schools of the said villages, respectively.
