- 2. Rule 5 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "twenty shillings" and the substitution therefor of the words "forty shillings".
- 3. Paragraph (3) of rule 4 of the principal Rules is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:-

"(3) The treasurer shall be paid—

- (a) a remuneration of five per centum of all rates and charges collected by him;
- (b) such of his out of pocket expenses as may be sanctioned by the Committee." (M.P. 671/45.)

## No. 274. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Dherinia, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the Gazette.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF DHERINIA UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them under section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Dherinia hereby make the following rules:-

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Dherinia) (Amendment) Rules, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Dherinia) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Dherinia) Rules, 1938 and 1949.

2. The following rules shall be substituted for rules 20 and 46, respectively, of the principal Rules:-

"Rule 20.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the owner of, or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house, that is to say:-(a) for every bullock, camel, cow or ox ... 6 (b) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 10 okes carcass weight ... (c) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 10 okes or under 2 carcass weight ... (d) for every swine above 30 okes carcass weight 6 (e) for every swine of 30 okes or under carcass weight Rule 46.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:— (a) for every carcass of bullock, camel, cow or ox (b) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 3 10 okes carcass weight (c) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 10 okes or under carcass weight (d) for every carcass of swine above 30 okes carcass
