**THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES  
LAW, 1948.**

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 12 (4).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 (4) of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, 1948, and with reference to the Notice of the Commissioner of Limassol dated the 23rd day of December, 1948, and published under No. 454 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 23rd December, 1948, relating to a spring known as "Pano Perdikes" in the vicinity of Anoyira, in the District of Limassol, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition under the provisions of the said Law, of the aforementioned spring, particulars whereof are specifically set out in the said Notice, to vest and be registered in the name of the Water Commission of Anoyira.

**No. 276. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.**

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

Whereas by a notification dated the 28th day of June, 1947, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 3rd July, 1947, the Governor declared under sections 2 and 3 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, the erection within the District of Larnaca of a power station, offices, workmen's quarters and any other erections or structures as are from time to time considered to be necessary in connection with a scheme for the generation and supply of electricity in Cyprus to be an undertaking of public utility and authorized its carrying out and entrusted under section 4 of the aforesaid Laws its supervision and effectuation to the Controller of Supplies, Transport and Marketing;

And whereas it is found now desirable to entrust its supervision and effectuation to the Chief Engineer, Central Electrification Scheme :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the aforesaid undertaking to the Chief Engineer, Central Electrification Scheme, in lieu of the Controller of Supplies, Transport and Marketing.
