THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) (FINANCE)
REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1949.

AUTHORIZATION UNDER REGULATION 4 (2).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (2) of regulation 4 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1940 to 1949, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby appoint the banks set out in the Schedule hereto to be authorized dealers for the purposes of the aforesaid Regulations and do hereby authorize the said banks, subject to the provisions of the aforesaid Regulations, to deal in matters set out in paragraph (2) of regulation 4 of the aforesaid Regulations.

2. All previous authorizations in this respect are hereby revoked.

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.
