THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2367

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

*Authority to the Village Health Commission of Kolossi (Limassol District)
to contract a loan.*R. E. TURNBULL,
Acting Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. That the Village Health Commission of Kolossi (Limassol District) (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") is hereby authorized to borrow from the loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of four hundred and thirty-five pounds (£435) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

(a) That the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Commission to the Lender in ten equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest).

(b) That the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Commission for the erection of a village market.

2. That for the purposes of securing the repayment of the sums due under the loan the Commission is hereby authorized, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, to mortgage to the Lender all charges and rates now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Commission under the provisions of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948.

THE BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREAS LAW, 1948.

REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 3.

R. E. TURNBULL,
Acting Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Bombardment Range Areas Law, 1948, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Bombardment Range Areas Regulations, 1949.

2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

"aircraft" includes all balloons whether fixed or free, kites, gliders, airships, aeroplanes, seaplanes, flying boats and other flying machines;

"bombardment practice" includes the firing of all kinds of ammunition (including rocket projectiles) from vessel or aircraft and the dropping of live or other bombs from aircraft and any or all of such operations;

"Bombardment Range Area" means any area in the Colony declared as such under the provisions of section 2 of the Law;
