THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) (FINANCE) REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1949.

NOTICE.

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to appoint the Controller of Supplies for the time being (with effect from the 1st day of January, 1949), to be "Exchange Officer" generally for the purposes of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1940 to 1949, and in particular:

- (a) to act on behalf of the Governor in respect of all or any of the following matters, that is to say:—
 - (i) in the event of an order being made under regulation 3, to grant permissions thereunder and to be the person to whom returns should be made thereunder;
 - (ii) to grant permissions under regulation 5 (1);
 - (iii) to grant certificates under regulation 5 (2) and 5 (5);
 - (iv) to be the person designated for the purposes of regulations 6 and 7;
 - (v) to give directions under regulation 11;
- (b) to act as an appropriate officer for the purposes of paragraph (3) and (5) of regulation 5.
- 2. The arrangements made by Notification No. 238 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 17th June, 1948, are cancelled, and the appointment of Mr. Sidney Montague Rich as "Exchange Officer" is terminated as from the 1st day of January, 1949.

No. 31. THE TREE PLANTING (VILLAGE AREAS) LAW, 1948.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 20.
