THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2368

MADE UNDER SECTION 116 (a) (i).

Whereas in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 116 (a) (i) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, by an Order No. 2303 dated the 21st day of June, 1948, published under Notification No. 246 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 24th June, 1948, has authorized the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta to borrow the sum of twenty-three thousand pounds (£23,000) and ten thousand pounds (£10,000) on the terms and conditions contained in the said Order-in-Council and for the purposes therein specified ;

And whereas as regards the loan of £23,000 a part thereof would be utilized under paragraph (i) of clause (c) of the aforesaid Order-in-Council for the purchase of the premises therein specified, and their conversion into a Municipal Market ;

And whereas it is found inexpedient to purchase all the premises described in the aforesaid paragraph of the aforesaid clause and convert them into a Municipal Market as therein provided, but it is found expedient to purchase only the premises under plots Nos. 299, 300 and 301 and erect thereon a Municipal Market :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 116 (a) (i) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order that paragraph (i) of clause (c) of the afore-recited Order-in-Council should be amended to read and have effect as follows :—

“(i) for the purchase of the premises under plots Nos. 299, 300 and 301 within the Famagusta Old Town and the erection thereon of a Municipal Market, and ”
