

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Omodhos, in the District of Limassol, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF OMODHOS
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Omodhos hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Omodhos) (Amendment) Rules, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Omodhos) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Omodhos) Rules, 1938 and 1949.

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2. The following rules shall be substituted for rules 20, 32 and 46, respectively, of the principal Rules:—

"Rule 20.—The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house, that is to say:—

(a) For every bullock, camel, cow or ox not exceeding 50 okes	1	0
(b) For every bullock, camel, cow or ox exceeding 50 okes ..	1	3
(c) For every goat, kid, lamb or sheep	—	3
(d) For every swine not exceeding 50 okes	1	0
(e) For every swine exceeding 50 okes	1	3

Rule 32.—The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) Perishable goods valued up to 3s.	—	2
(b) Perishable goods valued from 3s. to 5s.	—	3
(c) Perishable goods valued from 5s. to 10s.	—	4
(d) Perishable goods valued from 10s. to 20s.	—	6
(e) Perishable goods valued from 20s. to 40s.	1	0
(f) Perishable goods valued from 40s. to 100s.	2	0
(g) Perishable goods valued from 100s. to 200s.	3	0
(h) Perishable goods valued over 200s. :— For every additional 200s.	3	0

Rule 46.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) For every carcass of sheep or goat or part thereof ..	—	6
(b) For every carcass of a young lamb or kid or part thereof	—	6
(c) For every carcass of ox, camel, cow or bullock or part thereof	1	0

(2) The fees in paragraph (1) of this rule prescribed shall not be payable by any person exposing any fresh meat in the meat market, who is a monthly or yearly lessee of any shop, stall or place in the meat market under rule 45 of these Rules."
