ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE
REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purpose of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Zivania Control) Order, 1949.

2. In this Order—

“appointed day” means the 14th day of September, 1949 ;

“authorized purchaser” means a person or body of persons duly authorized by the Vine Products Controller to purchase zivania ;

“dealer by retail” means any person selling zivania to a purchaser buying in such quantities as may be reasonably required for use or consumption in the purchaser’s household for a reasonable time and not for the purpose of resale ;

“manufacturer” means any person, other than a producer, who, after the appointed day, produces, processes, or manufactures zivania ;

“permit” means a written permit issued under the provisions of this Order either by the Vine Products Controller or by any person authorized by him in that behalf ;

“producer” means any person who, after the appointed day, produces, processes, or manufactures zivania by his own labour or through his agents or servants solely from the produce of a vineyard or vineyards owned by him or leased by him under a lease made before the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* ;

“purchase” includes an agreement, offer or attempt to purchase, or the making of any arrangements to purchase either directly or indirectly ;

“purchase by retail” means any purchase in such quantities as may be reasonably required for use or consumption in the purchaser’s household for a reasonable time and not for the purpose of resale ;

“sell” includes an agreement, offer or attempt to sell or the making of any arrangements to sell either directly or indirectly ;

“Vine Products Controller” means an officer appointed by the Governor as Vine Products Controller.

3. Within seven days from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, and thereafter from the date of a notice in the *Gazette* to this effect by the Vine Products Controller, every person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of zivania in excess of ten

okes shall complete and deliver to the Vine Products Controller a return in the form set out in the Schedule hereto in respect of the zivania in his possession or under his control.

4. Save under a permit, no manufacturer shall, after the appointed day, produce, process, or manufacture zivania.

5. Save under a permit, no manufacturer or producer shall, after the appointed day, sell any zivania except to an authorized purchaser.

6. Save under a permit, no person shall, after the appointed day, transport, move or permit or suffer to be transported or moved any zivania from ~~his~~ ^{any} town or village, ~~except~~ ^{except for the purpose of its delivery} to an authorized purchaser.

7. Save under a permit, no person, other than an authorized purchaser, shall, after the appointed day, purchase any zivania :

Provided that any person may purchase by retail from any dealer by retail any zivania reasonably required for use or consumption in the purchaser's household for a reasonable time.

8. No person who is not a manufacturer, a producer, an authorized purchaser, or the holder of a permit shall, after the appointed day, have in his possession or under his control any zivania in excess of ten okes.

9. The Vine Products Controller or any other person authorized by him in that behalf may—

- (a) attach such terms or conditions as he may think fit to any permit, and the holder of any such permit shall comply with all such terms and conditions ;
- (b) revoke any such permit.

10. Every person shall permit such person as the Vine Products Controller or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.

- (c) makes, under any of the provisions of this Order, any return which is false in any material particular ;
- (d) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or duties under the provisions of this Order,

2. In this Order—

“appointed day” means the 14th day of September, 1949;

“authorized purchaser” means a person or body of persons duly authorized by the Vine Products Controller to purchase raisins;

“dealer by retail” means any person selling raisins to a purchaser buying in such quantities as may be reasonably required for use or consumption in the purchaser’s household for a reasonable time and not for the purpose of resale;

“permit” means a written permit issued under the provisions of this Order either by the Vine Products Controller or by any person authorized by him in that behalf;

“producer” means any person who, after the appointed day, produces any raisins either by his own labour or through his agents or servants;

“purchase” includes an agreement, offer or attempt to purchase, or the making of any arrangements to purchase either directly or indirectly;

“purchase by retail” means any purchase in such quantities as may be reasonably required for use or consumption in the purchaser’s household for a reasonable time and not for the purpose of resale;

“raisins” means boiled, scalded or sun dried raisins produced in Cyprus but does not include sultanas;

“sell” includes an agreement, offer or attempt to sell or the making of any arrangements to sell either directly or indirectly;

“Vine Products Controller” means an officer appointed by the Governor as Vine Products Controller.
