## THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Ayios Amvrosios, in the District of Limassol, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION  
OF AYIOS AMVROSIOS UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Ayios Amvrosios hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Ayios Amvrosios) (Amendment) Rules, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Ayios Amvrosios) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Ayios Amvrosios) Rules, 1938 and 1949.

2. The following rules shall be substituted for rules 32 and 46, respectively, of the principal Rules :—

“Rule 32.—The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say :—

(d) Perishable goods valued over 10 <i>s.</i> —2 <i>s.</i> or one <i>para</i> per oke whichever sum is the larger.
