The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Evdhimou, in the District of Limassol, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the Gazette. RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF EVDHIMOU UNDER SECTION 9. In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Evdhimou hereby make the following rules:— 1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Evdhimou) (Amendment) Rules, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Evdhimou) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Evdhimou) Rules, 1938 and 1949. 2.
