THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

A. B. Wright, Governor.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to construct, within the limits of the village of Strovolos, a reservoir in connection with a scheme to provide an adequate supply of wholesome water for domestic purposes for the town of Nicosia:

Now, therefore, I, Andrew Barkworth Wright, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross and Bar, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sections 2 and 3 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, do hereby declare the construction, within the village area of Strovolos, of a reservoir, which is considered necessary in the aforesaid scheme, to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking under the provisions of the said Laws and do hereby, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the said Laws, entrust the supervision of the said undertaking to the Water Engineer.

Notification published under No. 348 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 15th September, 1949, is hereby cancelled.
