THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND CONTROL) LAW, 1948.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, 1948, I hereby direct that during the period between the date of publication of this Order in the *Gazette* and 30th November, 1949, flocks within the area of Ayios Nikolaos village shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure :

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.

THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 5.

With reference to the Notification published under No. 276 in Supplement No. 3 to *Gazette* No. 3448 of 21st July, 1949, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

All that area of private land situated in the village of Ormidhia in the District of Larnaca at the locality Moutti tou Dracou, comprising 151 donums or thereabouts, bounded on the north by the Xylotymbou forest on the east by private property on the south by seashore and on the west by seashore and the Xylotymbou forest, and including plots Nos. 34/3, 34/2, 34/1, 34/4, 34/5 (partly), 33, 33/1, 33/2, 32, 31, 30, 30/1, 30/2, 30/3, 29 and 29/1 (partly), of the Government Survey Plan No. XLI.21, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan marked "Central Electrification Scheme, Dhekalia Power Station Site" and dated 26th July, 1949, deposited with the Commissioner, Larnaca.

The road from Larnaca to Ormidhia is excluded from the area to be acquired.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands is required within 6 weeks from the date of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my Office in Larnaca.
