THE POLICE LAW, 1947.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ACTING COMMISSIONER OF POLICE, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE ACTING GOVERNOR, UNDER SECTION 58.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 58 of the Police Law, 1947, I, the Acting Commissioner of Police, with the approval of the Acting Governor, do make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Regulations, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Police Regulations, 1947 and 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Police Regulations, 1947 to 1949.

2. Regulation 52 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended—

(a) by the insertion thereto immediately after sub-paragraph (1) of the following sub-paragraph:—

*REPL. S.L. 1950, }
6-4-50, p. 120 }*

"(1A) Non-commissioned officers and constables may be granted vacation leave at the rate of 3½ days for each completed month of service. Leave may not be accumulated in respect of more than 36 months' service." ;

(b) by the deletion from sub-paragraph (2) thereof of the words "vacation leave" (lines 1 and 2).

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LEFKONIKO.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Lefkoniko hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Lefkoniko) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Lefkoniko) Bye-laws, 1940 to 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Lefkoniko) Bye-laws, 1940 to 1949.

2. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the Second Schedule (Bye-law 179 (1) (b)), relating to Entertainment Duty, and the following Schedule substituted therefor :—

“SECOND SCHEDULE.

(Bye-law 179 (1) (b).)

ENTERTAINMENT DUTY.	Rates
(i) On each ticket the total price of which is over 1 <i>p.</i> but does not exceed 4½ <i>p.</i>	s. <i>p.</i> — 0½
(ii) On each ticket the total price of which is over 4½ <i>p.</i> but does not exceed 1 <i>s.</i>	— 1
(iii) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 1 <i>s.</i> but does not exceed 2 <i>s.</i>	— 1½
(iv) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 2 <i>s.</i> but does not exceed 4 <i>s.</i>	— 2
(v) On each ticket the total price of which is 4 <i>s.</i> or over	— 4 ”

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Galini, in the District of Nicosia, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF GALINI
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Galini hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Galini) (Amendment) Rules, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Galini) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Galini) Rules, 1938 and 1949.

2. The following rules shall be substituted for rules 20, 32, 46 (1), and 54 (1) respectively, of the principal Rules :—

“Rule 20.—The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house, that is to say :—

(a) for every bullock, camel, cow or ox	2	0
(b) for every goat, kid, lamb or sheep	1	0
(c) for every swine below 30 okes of weight	1	0
(d) for every swine of a weight of 30 okes and over	2	0

Rule 32.—The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say :—

(a) for every animal load	—	6
(b) for every cart load	1	0
(c) for every lorry load	2	0
