**No. 389. THE ALIENS AND IMMIGRATION LAW, 1949.**

ORDER BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 9 (3).

Whereas by an Order of the Acting Governor made under section 9 (3) of the Aliens and Immigration Law, 1949, and published under Notification No. 266 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th July, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), British Consular visas were dispensed with in the cases therein provided;

And whereas a visa-abolition agreement was concluded between the United Kingdom and San Marino which applies to the Colony:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9 (3) of the Aliens and Immigration Law, 1949, I, the Governor, do hereby order that the principal Order be amended to read and have effect as if in the Schedule thereto the name of "San Marino" were inserted therein in its appropriate alphabetical order.
