Whereas the Governor has, under section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1949, ordered the Village Commissions for Moslem schools mentioned in the second column of the Schedules hereto to provide school buildings, premisos, playgrounds, yards, gardens or teachers' dwellings ;

And whereas the necessary estimates and plans have been prepared under section 53 of the above-mentioned Laws;

And whereas loans amounting to the sums mentioned in the third column of the Schedules hereto have, under section 51 (1) and (2), been raised to meet the expense of providing such buildings as aforesaid:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 71 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1949, I, the Governor, do hereby order that in order to provide for the annual interest and sinking fund in respect of the loans aforesaid the sums of money mentioned in the fourth column of the said Schedules hereto be recovered from the Mohammedan taxpayers of the villages mentioned in the second column of the said Schedules in the manner prescribed by section 73 of the above Laws.
