No. 408. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 3) 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2385 MADE UNDER SECTION 4 (a).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 (a) of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 3) 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Ports Order, 1949.

2. The places set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto the limits whereof are fixed in the second column of the said Schedule shall be and are hereby appointed to be ports for all the purposes of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 3) 1948.

3. The Ports Order, 1936 and the Ports (Zyyi) Order, 1938, are hereby *Gazette*: 14.9.193

14.9.1936 Suppl. No. 3 :

4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 14,10,1938 1st January, 1948.

Famagusta	The territorial waters of Cyprus contained within a lin drawn 062° to the high seas from Ayios Varnava Church and a line drawn 062° to the high seas from point on the foreshore through a rock 1 foot high in line with Varosha Town, on Admiralty Char No. 851 of the 8th August, 1941.	
LARNACA	The territorial waters of Cyprus contained within a lin drawn 089° to the high seas from Livadhia Churc Belfry and a line drawn 089° from the Mosqu (Hala Sultan Tekke), on Admiralty Chart No.85 of the 8th August, 1941.	
ΖΥΥΙ	The territorial waters of Cyprus contained within line drawn 162° to the high seas from the point of intersection of the western bank of Maroni Rive with the Mediterranean Sea and a line drawn 162 to the high seas from Cape Dolos, on Admiralt Chart No. 850 of the 4th October, 1940.
