A PROCLAMATION.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Governor.

Whereas it is expedient that the village of Kremama Kamilou, in the District of Kyrenia, should be abolished:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, Andrew Barkworth Wright, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross and Bar, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby proclaim that the village of Kremama Kamilou in the District of Kyrenia shall, for all administrative purposes, be abolished as from the 1st day of December, 1949, and that the whole of the present area of the said village shall be transferred to Panagra village in the District of Kyrenia and shall form one common area of the said village of Panagra as from the said date.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Nicosia, this 4th day of November, 1949.
