In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 3) 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Raw Cotton) Reduction Order, 1949.

2. Raw cotton shall be admitted into the Colony at the reduced rates of 2 per centum and 10 per centum *ad valorem*, preferential and general tariff, respectively.

3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1949.
