their respective names.

No. 446. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to establish a Turkish Rural Central School, at Pergamos, in the District of Larnaca, and that certain lands are needed in connection therewith:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the establishment of a Turkish Rural Central School, at Pergamos, in the District of Larnaca, and the acquisition of lands in connection therewith to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Director of Education.
