## NOTICE No. 250 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 74 and the substitution therefor of the following Part.

## "PART 74.—METHYLATED SPIRITS.

Type of Methylated Spirit	Retail Price	Wholesale Price
Denaturated or methylated spirits (locally known as Spirito tou Kaminetou) of a minimum Strength of 80° Gay Lussac or 40° over proof 'Sikes' Hydrometer'.	3s. & 2p. per oke.	3s. per oke

## In this Part of the Schedule-

the term 'oke' means one-eighth of a kouza or  $1\frac{1}{8}$  quarts (as defined in the Weights and Measures Law, 1890);

the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of methylated spirits in quantities of not less than 10 okes or  $1\frac{1}{4}$  kouzas at any one time or at any single transaction.

Modification.—Provided that where methylated spirits are sold in any village outside a radius of 3 miles of a Commissioner's office, there may be added to the maximum retail price two piastres per oke."
