**THE PROPERTY OF HIS MAJESTY (THEFT AND POSSESSION)
LAWS, 1946 TO 1948.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2392

MADE UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Laws, 1946 to 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) (Continuance) Order, 1949.

2. The Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Laws, 1946 to 1948, shall continue in operation until the 31st day of December, 1950.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st January, 1950.

No. 495. THE TREE PLANTING (VILLAGE AREAS) LAW, 1948.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 20.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 20 of the Tree Planting (Village Areas) Law, 1948, I do hereby order that the Order relating to the Tree Planting Area of the village of Perakhorio, published in the *Gazette* of the 14th December, 1934, under Notification No. 1301 and extended for a period of five years under Notification No. 6 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 11th January, 1945, shall be extended for a further period of five years from the date of the expiration of the extended period thereof.
