THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2336

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Trikomo to contract a loan.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, do hereby order as follows:—

The Village Health Commission of Trikomo (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the lenders"), the sum of three thousand and eight hundred pounds (£3,800) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

(a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the lenders in twenty equal annual instalments

(comprising sinking fund and interest);

(b) the Village Health Commission shall, in each year and until the final repayment of the amount borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on the revenue the annual instalment payable in the year to which such estimates relate:

(c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Village Health

Commission for the purpose of erecting a market.
