5. Any person who acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of clause 3 of this Order is liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946.
