**THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2338**

**MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.**

*Authority to the Village Health Commission of Vouni to contract a loan.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

The Village Health Commission of Vouni (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lenders") the sum of three hundred and ninety pounds (£390) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the lenders in eight equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
- (b) the Village Health Commission shall, in each year and until the final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on the revenue the annual instalment payable in the year to which such estimates relate;
- (c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Village Health Commission for the purpose of providing a slaughter-house at Vouni.
